Effective methods for placing MODB and MODXYZ composite restorations without the usual problems of sensitivity, short lifespan, recurrent decay, fractured marginal ridges, or short lifespan. Trouble-free approaches to margin design, isolation, hemostasis, matrixing, and shade reproduction will be covered in addition to best adhesive and resin selections. Participants will be exposed to the Bandbender, a new posterior matrixing solution, and clinical methods to improve cure, increase reliability, and reduce placement time.

A new adhesive resin-bonded retainer design improving survival and cosmetics of the "Maryland" bridge. This simple yet powerful design has application for cost-effective single tooth replacement, as well as multiple-tooth splinting up to ten units with less clinical frustration than fiber splinting. Supplemental applications for removable prosthetics, such as fixing precision attachments and guide planes will be discussed.

Effective, reliable, and cosmetic composite resin treatment for chipped and saucered mandibular incisal edges, progressive maxillary anterior incisal wear, and lost vertical incisor height. Meet the demographics of the Baby Boomer population with this timely suite of procedures. Maintain the patient's appearance on an interim or permanent basis with the right preparations, resins, and protocols.
